

## TRANSPLANTING TIPS

Water deeply the area to transplant the day before.

Water the plants in containers for transplanting.

Sprinkle Fertilizer with Mycorrhizae in each hole (1 tablespoon).

Keep roots from getting dry or being exposed to sunlight too much.

Water plants after planting and once a day for 4 to 7 days.

Plant during the cool part of the evening or early morning to avoid stressing plants in heat of day.

Some plants may wilt after being transplanted, therefore it is extremely important to water deeply the day before planting.

## COMPOST TEA RECIPE

- Use only organic ingredients
- To be used weekly to feed container plants and garden vegetables
- Modify the mixture to enhance flowering growth by the addition of bat or bird guano, or and bud and bloom product, and decrease Nitrogen
- Dilute 50 % or more and / or use in foliar spray 90% Diluted
- In a large trash can filled with water add:
  - 2 shovel scoops of composted material from compost pile
  - 1 quart seaweed liquid (or fermented Kelp Meal)
  - 1 shovel Nitrogen (Perfect Blend Chicken Fertilizer with microbial life)
  - 2 cups Rainbow Grow or Rainbow Bloom Fertilizer
  - 4 cups Calcium (Dolomite Lime or Gypsum or Bone Meal)

LEAVE COVERED AND STIR DAILY

BEGIN USING IN 2 WEEKS

ADD WATER TO TRASH CAN AFTER TAKING SOME TEA OUT

DILUTE 50 % ++ AND WATER GARDEN IMMEDIATELY

SCREEN AND DILUTE 90 % FOR FOLIAR SPRAY
