How to read Rhododendron Cold hardiness Temperature

Hardiness temperature (°F), the minimum temperature a mature plant can take without serious injury.

The <u>minimum temperatures</u> for the following USDA Zone hardiness are:

0	USDA Zone 4	-20° to -30
0	USDA Zone 5	-10° to -20
0	USDA Zone 6	0° to -10°
0	USDA Zone 7	10° to 0°
0	USDA Zone 8	20° to 10°

In some catalogs rhododendrons are given a "hardiness ratings" as H-1, H-2, H-3, etc.
These "H" values correspond to minimum hardiness temperatures as follows:

•	H-1	to - 25° mid-point of USDA Zone 4
	H-2	to - 15°F, mid-point of USDA Zone 5
•	H-3	to - 5°F, mid-point of USDA Zone 6
	H-4	to 5°F, mid-point of USDA Zone 7
