<u>National Home Gets a Welcome Center:</u> As a combined VFW and Auxiliary special project of 2023-24 President Carla Martinez and Commander-in-Chief Duane Sarmiento, \$125,000 was raised and gifted to our National Home in Eaton Rapids, Michigan to convert the Administration Lobby into a Welcome Center.

With the Home being located miles from town, the Welcome Center will contain a retail space which will stock basic food and beverage needs for families and a clothing and souvenir space will provide convenient options for visitors and guests.

"The Welcome Center project will change the face of the administration space by providing a warm and welcoming environment for our visitors and residents as well as insuring postal and parcel mail gets to the residents in a timely manner", said VFW National Home Executive Director Mike Wilson. "We are truly thankful to Duane and Carla for taking on this project fundraiser and all those who donated to it," Wilson said.



The renovation is scheduled for completion in late fall.
