

How's it Possible...

Bermuda's pink sand is caused by tiny red organisms that grow beneath the coral reefs just off the shore. When they die and fall to the ocean floor, the organisms mingle with bits of coral and crushed shell that are washed onto the beach and make the sand appear an amazing shade of pink. Over time the pink sand gets pushed up the beach by pounding of waves, the sun bleaches the color.

When Did That Happen...

Early September 1609, Henry Hudson discovered Manhattan Island. He was a British explorer trying to find an easterly route to the Orient. Unable to sail through the icy Arctic Ocean he turned west to try to find a different route. Having heard rumors of a route to the Pacific Ocean, he tried to travel through North America. The first European contact with Manhattan was actually made by Verrazzano, but Hudson mapped the area.
