state Rep. Ana-Maria Ramos, April 16 might officially be designated as "Selena Day," honoring the late Texan music star Selena Quintanilla. In 1995, Governor of Texas George W. Bush declared April 16, Selena's birthday, as "Selena Day" in Texas. She has since been honored with awards, statues, and even a Selena museum in Corpus Christi. Selena was nominated for 86 awards, with 67 wins. She won 36 Tejano Music Awards, 14 Billboard Latin Music Awards, 10 Lo Nuestro Awards, five BMI Awards and one award from the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers. The proposed date for the holiday to be official in Texas, is April 16, 2021. It would have been the late singers 50th birthday. Bidi Bidi Bom! Bom! Happy early Selena day!




