How's it Possible...

The "Pop-A-Shot" electronic basketball shooting game was created in 1981 with Ken Cochran, a longtime basketball coach and former baseball Olympian. While he was at home recovering from heart surgery, he started to play with a mini basketball game on his desk to pass the time. Eventually he realized he was going to have to give up coaching and needed to find a new way to make money. He decided to put three small basketball rims on side-by-side backboards with a net that would return the balls to the shooters. He brought the new invention to sports camps, and the game was a total hit.

When Did That Happen...

The Woodstock Music Festival began on August 15, 1969, as half a million people waited on a dairy farm in Bethel, New York, for the three-day music festival to start. Billed as "An Aguarian Experience: 3 Days of Peace and Music," the epic event would later be known simply as Woodstock and become synonymous with the counterculture movement of the 1960s. Woodstock was a success, though the massive concert didn't go off without a hitch: last-minute venue changes, bad weather and the hordes of attendees caused major headaches. Still, despite-or because of-a lot of rock 'n' roll and rain, Woodstock was a peaceful celebration and earned its hallowed place in pop culture history.


