In the Philippines, the Giant Lantern Festival is held each year on the Saturday before Christmas Eve in the city of San Fernando, which is the "Christmas capital" of the Philippines. Eleven villages all participate in building their most elaborate lantern. Originally, the lanterns were created simply from 'papel de hapon' (Japanese origami paper). In Iceland, 13 troll-like characters come out to play during the 13 days leading up to Christmas. In Washington D.C., the lighting of the Menorah takes place. This is a ceremony marked with speeches, music, and activities for kids. Whether celebrating Christmas, Hanukkah, Kwanzaa or the holidays in general, think about what traditions are special to you!

Since that day, it has been translated into 37 languages and evolved into over 200 licensed and localized editions for 103 countries across the world. Charles B. Darrow of Germantown, PA created the game known today as Monopoly during the Great Depression. In 1934, he presented the game to executives at Parker Brothers and was rejected. A year later, after he sold 5,000 homemade copies of the game. Parker Brothers later bought the game. 
When Did That Happen...


