# What's Going on Here...



## How's it Possible...

Would you believe that the height of our infamous Eiffel Tower fluctuates!? The average height is 324 meters, but changes depending on the season. When the hot summer sun beats down on it, thermal expansion causes the metal to expand, making the tower grow. The tower can swell in height by as mcuh as 17 centimeters (6.67 iches). But once the hot sun goes down, the metal cools, and the tower shrinks back to its original size.

# When Did That Happen...

In July 1799 a basalt slab inscribed with ancient writing was discov-



ered near the town of Rosetta. The irregularly shaped stone contained fragments of passages written in three scripts: Greek, Egyptian hieroglyphics and Demotic. It was found by French soldiers who were rebuilding a fort in Egypt. Following Napoleon Bonaparte's invasion of Egypt in 1798, he ordered a group of scholars to seize any cultural artifacts and take them into French possession. French Egyptologist, Jean-Francois Champollion, who had taught himself ancient languages, ultimately cracked the code and deciphered the hieroglyphics using his knowledge of Greek as a guide. Once the Rosetta Stone inscriptions were translated, the language and culture of ancient Egypt were suddenly open to scientists as never before.


