Where in the World...

One of the most authentic food experiences you can have in Italy is to visit a food festival or *sagra*. Food festivals are like one big Italian dinner, with a few historic parades, dancing, and music is thrown in for good measure. For example, the Fiera Del Riso is the largest rice and risotto festival in Verona, Italy. You can eat taleggio rice, curried black rice and pear risotto. There are also historic parades and events dedicated to showcasing the rice farming process. In October, there is also the Mortadella Festival where mortadella is one of bologna's most loved products. It contains no artificial flavors, colors, or preservatives. At the festival, it is thinly sliced and served on bread. The festival features many street food stands where you can try the classic versions or the many twists of bologna by chefs. It takes place in the main square of the city and it's a real celebration of Bolognese culture.

What's Going on Here...

October : The Port Washington Chamber of Commerce, Port Washington BID, Residents Forward and Landmark on Main Street continues to have their Port Outdoors event, an open-air dining and shopping experience on Main Street. Port Outdoors Dine & Shop allows pedestrian-only zones on Thursday evenings from 4 to 9 PM until Oct. 15th. Parts of Main Street will be closed to traffic to allow the shops and restaurants to be on the street and enjoy meeting & talking to pedestrians.

October 18th : "Rocktoberfest" Rock out at the Sousa Band Shell. Free concert for the whole family presented by Bach to Rock feat. Porchlight. A concert benefitting Spectrum Designs Foundation and The Nicholas Center. A Port Washington based non-profit organization with a mission: to help individuals with autism lead full and productive lives through the world of work and in the community. The concert begins at 3 PM and ends at 7 PM, social distancing measures will be in effect please wear a mask.

How's it Possible...

Do you know how candy corn was invented? The original "Chicken Feed" was invented by George Renniger in 1898 in Philadelphia, PA. George worked at the Wunderie Candy Company where he made the candy kernel by hand in small batches. Originally George mixed together sugar and corn syrup because they looked like kernels he named it Chicken Feed. Soon after, the candy became popular because it only cost one penny. The Goelitz company now known as Jelly Belly company decided to advertise the candy kernels it was renamed as candy corn. It became a treat that was eaten during Thanksgiving and Easter. In the 1950's candy became popular for Halloween because it was advertised more than other candy. Now more than 35 million pounds of Candy Corn is sold every year. Candy Corn has its own national day on October 30th.

When Did That Happen...

On October 2, 1950, the character we all love today Charlie Brown is not just born; he was created by Charles Swatz. Swatz earned an Oscar nomination for the first Charlie Brown film, "A Boy Named Charlie Brown." It did not win the Oscar however, his TV programs won many Emmys. One of them was for the "Charlie Brown Thanksgiving" special. Fans also enjoyed Charlie Brown's Snoopy in his doghouse. In 2002, the Charlie Brown float became popular at the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade. He was so loved that he is the longest character to ever appear in the Macy's Day Parade as a balloon. Later on, a float of Snoopy was made in 2019. In 2015, Snoopy got a star on the Hollywood Walk Of Fame. In October this adorable young man and his best friend Snoopy will have a birthday. They both will turn 70, except Snoopy was created 2 days later.

The apple was sent to Messrs, Garcia, Jacobs and Co., for sale by public auction in Covent Garden Market on October 19, 1909. It sold for \$70, and the proceeds of that sale were presented to Charing Cross Hospital. This wonderful apple was grown in an 11 inch flower pot, the tree producing six mammoth fruits at the same time. It was this very tree which bore the giant apple of 1909. A well known expert, who inspected the largest apple in the world, expressed the opinion that its production would give a tremendous impetus to fruit growers in Great Britain.
