

Did you know that 46 million turkeys are eaten on Thanksgiving Day? According to the National Turkey Federation, they reported that 88 percent of Americans eat turkey on Thanksgiving. When Did That Happen...

On November 26, 1922, British archaeologist Howard Carter and his workmen discovered the tomb of King Tutankhamen in the Valley of the Kings in Egypt. King Tut was a king of ancient Egypt. He found the burial room hidden in the debris near the entrance of the nearby tomb of King Ramses VI. He entered the interior chambers of the tomb with fellow archaeologist Lord Carnarvon to find it miraculously intact. Carter carefully explored the four-room tomb over several years, uncovering an incredible collection of several thousand objects. His golden mask is on display at the

Egyptian Museum in Cairo, but the Tutankhamun collection will eventually move to the Grand Egyptian Museum, or GEM, slated to open next year. The exhibitions attracted over one million visitors, and in each there were less than 55 objects on show.




