

Where in the World...

Where can you get live crab from vending machines!? Weirdly enough, in China crabs are caught, packed in plastic boxes, and kept alive in refrigerated vending machines for sale. How's it Possible...

Back in 1853, a chef named George Crum was working at the Cary Moon restaurant in Saratgo Springs, NY. One hot, summer day, a customer stepped into the restaurant and ordered the restaurant's well known Moon's Fried Potatoes. Unfortunately, the customer complained that the fried potatoes were incredibly thick. Crum created multiple batches, each thinner than the last, but none were to his customer's liking. Finally, Crum did his best to cut the potatoes paper-thin, deep fried them so long that they became hard and crispy, and then salted them heavily. To his surprise, when he served this batch to the picky costomer, the customer was delighted! This dish of thinly siliced potatoes became known as the "Saratoga Chip" and the potato chip was born.

When Did That Happen...

American journalist Nellie Bly, born Elizabeth Jane Cochran, is best known for her amazing trip around the world. On November 14, 1889, she did this trip using only steamship, rickshaw, horse, and donkey. She was inspired by Jules Vernes' 1873 novel, Around the World in 80 Days; of which, William Perry Fogg, an adventurer and author, was the inspiration for the main character. This was an amazing accomplishment because it was done in only 72 days!
