IMAGE OF YEAR SECTION:

THIS SECTION MAXIMUM OF 12 ENTRIES:

Subject to the section limit above, up to three (3) photographs from 2023 may be submitted in each of the following Categories,

- PRINT COLOUR
- PRINT MONO
- DIGITAL COLOUR
- DIGITAL MONO

Photographs that have been entered in regular monthly competition during the year are eligible. Entries to be selected from your best scored competition entries during 2023. If insufficient qualifying photographs, including new members, you may include other work.

Members to submit entries in the same medium (Print or Digital) as entered in the monthly competitions.

Judge to select up to top 10 finalists and award Winner & Runner Up in each category. The others “Finalist”

From the top image of each category “Peter Reedman Perpetual Trophy” will be awarded to the Image of the Year.

TROPHY SECTION:

THIS SECTION MAXIMUM OF 6 ENTRIES

Images do not need to have been entered in regular monthly competition. Images entered in Image of Year Section above can also be entered in this section.

- **Goolwa & Surrounds: Print** (max 2 entries per member). An image that best depicts our immediate region.
- **Portrait: Print** (max 2 entries per member) Image of a person to show the character and emotion of the subject.
- **Skyscapes: Print** (max 2 entries per member) A photograph where the sky dominates. Land, Sea, or other features may be included (New in 2023)

OTHER AWARDS

Members entry is not required for the following:

Julie Barrien Memorial Trophy. This a perpetual trophy. To qualify the member must have entered a minimum of 5 entries in all 4 categories (Print and PDI Open, Mono & Set subject) Awarded to the best/highest calculated average score overall from ALL four sections/categories.

- **4 Awards - Best in Category – PRINT, PDI COLOUR, PDI MONO & PDI SET SUBJECT.** Awarded to the best/highest calculated average score in EACH section/category.

Prints to be delivered the day of the Exhibition to the venue at 1.30 to 2.30pm on Wednesday November 29nd to the South Lakes Golf Club, Billabong Rd, Goolwa South SA.

- Parts of all images and any post processing must be the exclusive work of the entrant.
- Entrants must own full copyright © of their images.
- Photographing others artwork can be a breach of copyright.
- Non-Complying images will be excluded.
- GCC reserves the right to reproduce entries for publicity purposes.
- Mono is defined as an image that is Monochrome only if it gives the impression of having no colour (i.e. contains only shades of grey which can include pure black and pure white)
OR
it gives the impression of being a greyscale image that has been toned in one colour across the entire image. (For example, sepia, blue, gold, etc.)
