Eligibility

- 1. Licensed dental hygienist in Nevada (membership in NDHA not required)
- 2. Outstanding service in leadership and/or community project(s)
- 3. Can nominate yourself or someone else

Hygienist of the Year Award

Deadline August 15, 2023 - Detailed Information

Eligibility

- 1. Licensed dental hygienist in Nevada
- 2. Outstanding leadership in local, state or national association and/or mentoring within the dental hygiene profession
- 3. Must be a nominated by a peer
- 4. Must be a member of NDHA

Mentor of the Year Award

Deadline August 15, 2023 - Detailed Information

Eligibility

- 1. Awarded to a mentor (any hygienist) from each component in the state
- 2. Mentor must be a current member of ADHA
- 3. Must be nominated by a second-year dental hygiene student from CSN or TMCC
- 4. Student must write an essay to include the following in a maximum of two pages
 - Name of mentor, phone number of mentor, and length of mentoring relationship
 - Name of protégé and detail hygiene school
 - How has your mentor helped you provide better care for your patients?
 - How has this mentoring relationship enhanced your life?

For all the above awards, the NDHA Board of Trustees will select the award recipient(s) and the award(s) will be presented at the Nevada Annual Session/House of Delegates

Dental Hygiene Student Leadership Award

Deadline August 15, 2023 -Detailed Information

<u>Eligibility</u>

- 1. Awarded to one first year or second year dental hygiene student from each dental hygiene program; College of Southern Nevada and Truckee Meadows Community College. Recent 2023 hygiene graduates eligible to apply
- 2. Student must have satisfactory academic achievement; a grade of "C" or better in all required coursed
- 3. Must be a member of SADHA during first year; second year students must be a member for both years. Membership must be kept current throughout the school year
- 4. Must write essay (minimum of one typewritten page) evaluating leadership abilities and how leadership is/was applied in SADHA The essay should include:
 - An assessment of leadership abilities, past and present
 - Experience in community service or volunteerism
 - An example of taking a goal from inception to completion
- 5. Prefer Nevada resident, but not mandatory
- 6. Applicants may apply for yourself or nominate another student

For all the above awards, the NDHA Board of Trustees will select the award recipient(s) and the award(s) will be presented at the Nevada Annual Session/House of Delegates
