Helping your child make the best effort to do homework - It is important to make the best, consistent workplace for homework that your home allows. Make sure that the space has good lighting, is comfortable to read and write and most importantly has no distractions. Provide help when needed, but not the answers - asking questions works well. If you have trouble with a subject, recruit an older child or neighbor to help. If you can, work on your 'homework'; pay bills, organize your schedule, or plan meals. If you can't do your 'homework' at the same time, let your child know when you are working on your 'homework'. This allows your child to see that even adults have homework and this models what a good student looks like.
