11 and 12 year-olds:

Tdapvaccine to help prevent tetanus, diphtheria, and whooping cough.

All incoming 7th graders need proof of a Tdap vaccine and 2 does of chickenpox vaccine before school starts.

Preteens may also need to catch up on other immunizations, including chicken pox (many don't have their second dose), MMR (measels, mumps and rubella) and hepatitis B. Two shots of chickenpox vaccine are now required before 7th grade in California.

You will be able to register, discuss times that work best for your schedule and get on a class list.

The Penn Valley Library is one of just a few libraries nationwide that will now offer access hours that allows patrons to use the library without staff present.

Beginning July 1st, 2021 the library will add operating days and hours and expand access to the community using the Open+ Access system. Open+ will add an additional 14 hours of operation each week to the 25 hours that the Penn Valley Library is normally open.

Open+ Access will initially be available Monday 7 a.m. to 9 a.m., Saturdays 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., and Sundays 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. While not at the same level of service as when staff is present to assist, patrons can step inside to browse, check out materials, pick up items that have been placed on hold, or grab some quiet time.
