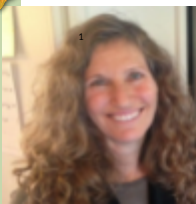

CDC authorized Second booster Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 boosters for ages 50+. The second booster is to be given 4 months after the first booster dose. Patient's 12 and older who are immunocompromised individuals. Pfizer remains the only approved vaccine for ages 12-17. People who received Johnson and Johnson Janssen for their first shot and booster.
