IMMUNIZATION CLINIC on the RIDGE SCHEDULED for JULY 12

On Tuesday, July 12 from 10 am-noon, Nevada County Public Health will offer an immunization clinic on the Oak Tree Campus. They will be offering the following childhood vaccines: Tdap, MMR, Varicella, Dtap, Polio, and Hep B for children. They will also have Tdap available for adults. Children must be accompanied by a parent or proof of guardianship OR provide a legible written note from their parent authorizing another adult's consent for immunizations (you can find the form the on Nevada County website under immunizations consent). To access childhood vaccines, you also MUST have the child's shot record. No record, no shots; the most up-to-date record from their Primary care provider or the school OR the yellow paper immunization card. And, finally, please be sure to bring insurance information if you are insured. COVID vaccines for approved age groups will also be offered; bring your vaccine card to insure proper intervals between shots. Persons that receive COVID vaccines will need to stay in the immediate area for observation by the administering nurse for a minimum of 15 minutes. Should they have any health contraindications the observation time will be extended to a minimum of 30 minutes.
