March 22: Stressors on Parents and Kids—and How to Help

Do you find yourself feeling stressed, frustrated, and in need of nurturing as a parent or caregiver? You are not alone! Join other parents in this participatory class where we explore our unique needs and how we can better meet them, even in the midst of our busy—and often overwhelming—schedules. We will then turn to stressors in the lives of our children, and how we can best guide and help them to cope—and even thrive—as they manage their own life challenges.

April 19: Loving Discipline and Natural Consequences

Effective and loving discipline is a common area of struggle for parents and caregivers. How do we set limits from a calm and empathetic place when we are triggered? Which consequences work in a way that engenders self-responsibility in our children?
