

**17 September, Saturday :** Depart from your respective airport for an overnight flight on LOT Polish Airlines to Warsaw. Meals provided enroute.

**18 September, Sunday:** Arrive in Warsaw at approximately noon, gather your luggage, proceed through customs and immediately board our luxurious motorcoach. On the way to the 4-star Hotel Sobieski, enjoy a sightseeing tour of Warsaw including Lasienski Park (Chopin’s Monument, Pilsudski’s statue). Check into our hotel with time to explore or to rest and prepare for a group dinner at a local restaurant. (D)

**19 September, Monday:** After breakfast, team up with our local guide, a native of Warsaw, for an in-depth city tour of iconic sights including City Square, Old Town, the Palace of Culture, the changing of the guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the Warsaw Uprising Museum. The afternoon is free to explore Warsaw with lunch on your own. Enjoy a group dinner with outstanding Folklore entertainment. (B)(D)

**20 September, Tuesday:** After breakfast, travel by motorcoach to Tykocin, a medieval town. Enjoy a tour of the castle, synagogue and market square. We will stay at a charming, historic and rustic Country Manor. Time to explore the grounds and view the resident stork nests and museum before enjoying a bounteous country dinner. (B)(D)

**21 September, Wednesday:** Following breakfast, travel by motorcoach to Olsztyn. On the way, visit the Wolf’s Lair, Hitler’s first eastern front headquarters, hidden in the Mazurian woods. Check into the Hampton Inn and get ready for a spectacular visit to an authentic country farm with dinner and Folklore with local musicians. We don’t want to give away the details, but this will be one of the highlights of our trip!!(B)(D)

**22 September, Thursday:** After breakfast, depart for Gdansk where Global Solidarity began, with a visit along the way to Malbork, the largest surviving brick castle from the 14<sup>th</sup> century. Enjoy lunch at the castle. Continue to Gdansk, and check into the Radisson Hotel and Suites on the Baltic coast and explore the city. Dinner on your own. (B)(L)

**23 September, Friday:** Following breakfast, join our group for a half-day city walking tour of Gdansk. Enjoy a concert performed on the largest European antique organ at the Oliva Cathedral. Visit an amber workshop. Use the afternoon to explore, shop, sightsee and enjoy the local cuisine with lunch on your own. Experience delightful folklore and the traditions of the Kashubian region as we enjoy dinner at a picturesque family resort. (B)(D)

**24 September, Saturday:** After breakfast, enjoy a boat tour of Gdansk Harbor and a visit to Westerplatte, where WWII began. Enjoy lunch on your own at the Sopot Resort on the Baltic coast. Group dinner at a local restaurant. (B)(D)

**25 September, Sunday:** After breakfast, say farewell to Gdansk and head to Torun, the birthplace of Copernicus. Check into the Hotel Bulwar. Tour Torun and enjoy a visit to the Gingerbread Factory and Museum. Farewell group dinner and music at a local restaurant. (B)(D)

**26 September, Monday:** After breakfast, travel to Warsaw for our flight back to the US.

Meals Provided Daily: B (breakfast), L (lunch), D (dinner)

RESERVATIONS/PAYMENTS:

A Deposit of \$500 per person is required at the time of booking. Full payment due before July 13, 2022

TOUR COST:

The cost of this tour/package includes Land/your Airline ticket, Hotels, Meals and Entertainment fees.

Tour price is based on lowest fares, tariffs and foreign currency exchange levels as of January 2022. It is subject to adjustment in the event of any significant changes in the tariffs or exchange levels in which case the rates changes will be passed on.

TOUR ARRANGEMENTS:

Air transportation will be provided via LOT or other authorized carrier. Hotel accommodations are arranged in twin bedded rooms with private bath. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement cost shown. While every effort will be made to provide sharing of accommodations for persons booking alone, when requested, it cannot be guaranteed and payment of single supplement must be paid before departure when billed. Triple rooms are not available.

Unused hotel accommodations or any other unused features of this tour are not refundable or exchangeable. The right is reserved to substitute hotels and sightseeing features if it becomes necessary.

Tour members must be able to get on and off the motor coach unaided and not require walking devices or wheelchairs. Exceptions available.

**DOCUMENTS:** A valid U.S. or foreign passport is required. To apply for passport, contact your local Passport Agency or nearest U.S. Post Office. Check the validity of your passport and be sure it is valid for at least three months after your return flight. Please be sure your current passports are valid for time of travel.

CANCELLATIONS:

Refund of deposit will be made for cancellations that are received by July 13, 2022 less a \$75. administration fee. There will be no refunds after the full payment due date of July 13, 2022. It is recommended that you elect to enroll in the group insurance to cover possible cancellation of trip. Airline tickets, once issued are subject to the airline cancellation policy.
