Constitution

ARTICLE I

Name and Objectives

SECTION 1: The name of the club shall be Western Washington Australian Shepherd Association (WWASA)

SECTION 2: THE OBJECTIVES OF THE CLUB SHALL BE:

- (a) To encourage and promote quality in the breed of purebred Australian Shepherds and to do all possible to bring their natural qualities to perfection.
- (b) To urge members and breeders to accept the standard of the breed as approved by The American Kennel Club as the standard of excellence by which the Australian Shepherd shall be judged.
- (c) To do all in its power to protect and advance the interests of the breed by encouraging sportsmanship competition at dog shows, obedience trials, agility trials, AKC Rally® trials, tracking tests, herding trials and all venues the Australian Shepherd partakes in.
- (d) To conduct sanctioned matches, dog shows, obedience trials, agility trials, AKC Rally[®] trials, tracking tests, herding instinct test/herding trials under the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club.
- SECTION 3. The club shall not be conducted or operated for profit and no part of any profit or remainder or residue from dues or donations to the club shall insure to benefit of any member or individual.

SECTION 4. The members of the club shall adopt and may from time to time revise such bylaws as may be required to carry out these objectives.
