North Andover Thrift Shop Announces \$3,400 in Community Giving to Support Conservation, Food Security, Family Services, and Education

North Andover, MA – July 13, 2026 — Continuing its longstanding tradition of reinvesting in the Merrimack Valley, the North Andover Thrift Shop has announced **\$3,400 in charitable giving** supporting local organizations dedicated to environmental stewardship, food security, family services, and education.

As part of this latest round of giving, the Thrift Shop has awarded **\$2,900** in grants to four nonprofit organizations and has **set aside \$500** toward its annual scholarship to be awarded through the **North Andover Scholarship Foundation** to a North Andover High School student in early 2027.

The following grants have been awarded:

- **Friends of North Andover Trails – \$500** to support the organization's efforts to preserve, maintain, and expand North Andover's network of public trails, encouraging outdoor recreation, environmental education, and conservation for residents and visitors alike.
- **Clean River Project – \$1,000** in support of its work to protect and restore local waterways through river cleanups, environmental education, and community engagement, helping to improve the health of the Merrimack River and surrounding ecosystems.
- **Sarah's Place – \$500** to support its mission of providing a safe, engaging adult day health program for older adults and adults living with cognitive or physical impairments. Sarah's Place helps participants remain active and connected while supporting their ability to continue living in their own homes.
- **People's Pantry – \$900** to help provide food and essential groceries to individuals and families facing food insecurity throughout the Merrimack Valley.

"Every purchase made through our eBay store helps strengthen the Merrimack Valley," said a spokesperson for the Board of the North Andover Thrift Shop. "Whether we're helping preserve local trails, protecting our rivers, supporting families in need, addressing food insecurity, or investing in the education of our young people, our mission remains the same—to give back to the communities that have supported us for more than seven decades."

Founded more than 70 years ago, the North Andover Thrift Shop is an entirely volunteer-run nonprofit. Following the closure of its longtime Sutton Street location, the organization successfully transitioned to operating exclusively through an online eBay storefront after being unable to secure a new physical location. This innovative approach has enabled the Thrift Shop to continue transforming donated goods into meaningful charitable support while remaining deeply rooted in the Merrimack Valley.
