The pro-ordinance supporters say that some Mason residents will be grandfathered, so they won't be impacted by the inverse condemnation ordinance. That is NOT true! <u>This is a "ZERO TOLERANCE" ordinance</u>. EVERY infraction will be prosecuted even if you don't own the land where the alleged violation occurred (<u>up to \$100,000 & 1 year in prison</u>.) One selectman said <u>VIOLATORS SHOULD BE PUNISHED SEVERELY</u> to set an example.

- They say we need this oppressive new ordinance to protect our water. <u>That is not true</u>.
- Our water is <u>already protected by comprehensive STATE and FEDERAL</u> environmental regulations. The NH Department of Environmental Services has <u>statewide jurisdiction</u> of all wetlands. <u>ALL activities, "regardless of size or scale, in or</u> on the banks of a surface water body, or in a wetland, require a permit from the state."
- Pets and livestock are NOT included in the ordinance's permitted uses (Section H.).
- New, nearby "swales" could be breeding areas for <u>deadly mosquito-borne diseases</u>.
- Bureaucrats can enter our property unannounced or seek violations with DRONES.
- We don't need this "taking" or our property to "protect Mason's rural character."
