

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### **USAGE**

Step 1-First, position the stretcher next to the bed, and ensure locks being applied to both the stretcher and the bed.

Step 2-One care taker stands next to the patient and the other care taker should carry Anulon Patrans and position themselves on the other side of the bed where the patient will be moved towards.

Step 3- The care taker alongside the stretcher lifts the patient (one half turn) just enough to place the Anulon Patrans under the body of the patient. Meanwhile the other care taker slides the Patrans partway under the patient when he is being half turned. (Anulon Patrans should extend on to the bed to form a bridge between the bed and stretcher).

Step 4- Then the care taker who is on the side of the bed need to hold the sheet which is under the patient and hold it with the palms up grip keeping their elbows close to their body.

Step 5- Care taker alongside the stretcher places his hand against the patients shoulder and hip area with his fingers pointing upwards and forearms parallel to the bed. Then the care taker from the other end holding the sheet pulls the sheet on the count of 3 and the care taker from the opposite side pushes the patient slowly so as to make the transfer smooth.
