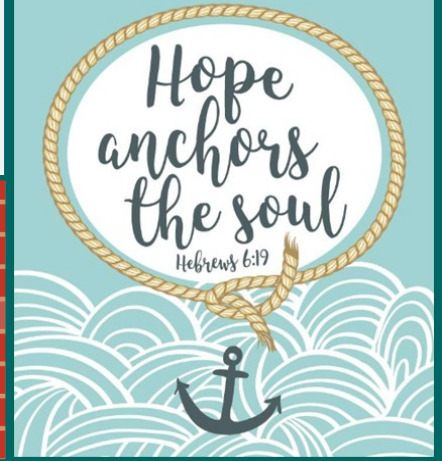


HOPE AT THE BRICK HOUSE
