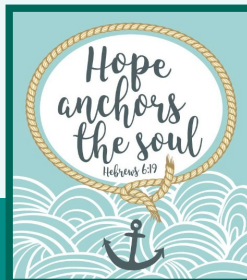

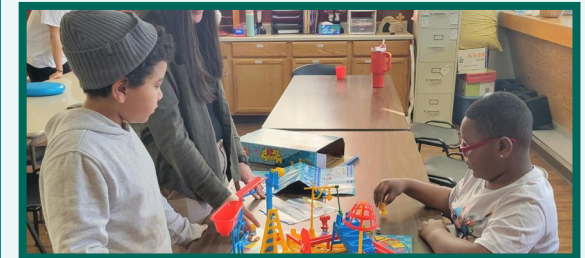


After School Program
