2022 Midlothian Soccer Association Scholarship Program

Midlothian Soccer Association is excited to announce that we will again, be awarding two (2), scholarships, at a value of \$500 each, in 2022. One to a male student and another to a female student, planning to attend a post-secondary educational institution (PSEI) beginning in the fall of 2022, and has not previously been admitted as a student of any PSEI. The criteria for awarding the scholarships will be based on **community service** and **giving back to the game of soccer**. Participation in soccer at the collegiate level is not a prerequisite. Scholarships will be paid directly to the PSEI.

Eligibility

- Seniors in high school when the application is submitted. Those students who are currently enrolled in a PSEI (or the equivalent) as a senior in high school will not be excluded from consideration.
- Must be enrolled at Midlothian High Scholl, Midlothian Heritage High School OR be enrolled as a senior in a TEA approved program AND also have a permanent residence in the current MISD Attendance Zone
- Participation (as a player) in a US Youth Soccer program during the applicant's junior or senior year.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 in a college prep curriculum.
- Demonstrate active service to their community and a strong desire to give back to the game of soccer.

Application Procedure

An applicant must include **all** of the following:

- 1. A completed Application;
- 2. A most current high school **Transcript**;
- 3. A personal, typed **Essay** (500 words or less) describing how soccer has personally affected your life and/or the development of your character; and
- 4. A total of two (2) Letters of Recommendation from the following: teacher, principal, coach, counselor, or community leader. One (1) letter must be from a principal, counselor or coach. Submitted letters must be from persons of different professions. Each letter must include a contact number, an email address and the title of the person(s) completing the recommendation.

Completed applications and all submitted material must be **postmarked no later than April 9, 2022**. All materials submitted with the application will not be returned.

Scholarship recipients, will be notified by e-mail on or before **May 21, 2022**, and will be publicly announced upon acceptance.
