Business and Economics

- [Innovation Ecosystem](#): Mark Bidwell and Roddy Millar interview guests on innovation, change and leadership that apply to small businesses, large businesses, executives and entrepreneurs
- [Smart Women, Smart Power](#): Interviews with top women in corporations, government, and national security, focused on international business and global affairs. These women have mastered the fundamental capabilities – learn from their experiences!
- [The Economist Podcasts](#): A range of podcasts from one of the world's most influential newsmagazines. Includes Economist Radio, Economists Asks, and more.
- [Spectacular Failures](#): We really can learn as much from studying failure as we can from studying successes. Host Lauren Ober helps us do that, with a sharp sense of humour and a strong emphasis on facts. Learn the full story about business failures and the people behind them. Great for entrepreneurs, corporate leaders, and everyone in between.

Communication

- [Clear and Vivid](#): Hosted by beloved actor, director, and all-around science lover Alan Alda of MASH fame, this podcast explores communication and how it brings people together from many angles. Fascinating interviews with everyone from a former Neo-Nazi to cellist Yo-Yo Ma. There's even an episode with Alda's former MASH co-stars, about how they all worked together. Alda's interview style is a communication lesson in itself, and his guests really respond to it. Guest answers to the podcast's trademark 'Four Quick Questions for Four Quick Answers' are always funny.
- [The Moth Podcast](#): Telling a story is the best way to get people to hear and appreciate your message. Listen to some expert story-tellers and learn from their style and content.

- [Death Sex and Money](#): Host Anna Sale interviews real people about real topics that we are often reluctant to discuss. Past episodes have included living alone, aging well, and changing your life. Anna is a great interviewer; listen to her and learn how to ask questions that get people talking.
- [The TED Radio Hour](#): Host Guy Raz brings together excerpts from several TED talks and interviews with the speakers around a common theme. Past episodes have included Misconceptions, the Money Paradox, Courage, and Self-Improvement – all topics relevant to women who want to take charge of their lives.
