




Habib Khan

Flights

Flights are not included with the package, so depending on when you book

Insurance

We do not cover flight cancellations or damaged/lost property. It would be best to take out your own travel insurance.

Expenses

You should bring extra pocket money to spend on food and souvenir shopping. Usually £100-£150 is enough for the trip.

Currency Exchange

You can exchange money in the UK or Spain. Many places in Spain have reasonable rates. Alternatively, you can cash out from the ATMs in Spain.

Accommodation

While the tour's price is based on 2/3 people sharing in a 4* hotel (the maximum is 3 in a room), there is a single-room option at an additional cost of £200 per person.

Infants

Please make special requests to accommodate infants, such as a cot, and let the organisers know beforehand so we can arrange it with the hotel. Car seats may incur an extra charge and are subject to availability.

Travel Documents

The traveller is responsible for obtaining a valid passport and any necessary visas.

Weather & Accessories

The temperature in Spain will be mild during the trip, so please pack suitable clothing and skin protection lotions and creams. Appropriate footwear is advised since we will be walking and hiking. You will also need UK-to-Europe plug converters. Power banks will be handy, too.



Travelling to Spain

For those who wish to travel as a group, we will fly from Manchester to Malaga. Please come the night before so we can all fly together early in the morning that day. You can travel from your respective cities if you'd like; in this case, you'll need to reach Malaga airport by the designated time to make sure you get the bus for the 2-hour journey to the hotel in Cordoba.

Meeting Point at Malaga Airport

When you arrive at Malaga Airport, please go to the arrivals hall. Once you have collected your luggage, follow the exit signs. When you go through the sliding glass doors into the arrivals hall, please keep going 'straight' ahead towards the La Manon cafe/restaurant (the only one in the arrivals hall). There is a large waiting area behind La Manon Cafe with seating. Towards the back are toilets and a prayer room.

Tour Itinerary

Meals
