PARENT DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP PROCEDURES

To ensure the safety and accountability of all cadets, the following procedures are to be observed at every parade night or activity:

- Parents must **escort their cadet(s)** to and from the school (or activity) **parking lot**.
- Parents **must sign in and sign out** their cadet(s) with the **designated staff member** at each parade or event.
- **Drop-off time** is no later than **18:20 hours** to allow cadets to form up **for Colours and Prayers Parade**.
- Parents are welcome to **remain and observe the opening Colours & Prayers parade** at 18:30 hours.
- **Pick-up time** is **20:30 hours** following **Sunset Parade**, presentations, and announcements.
- Parents are **encouraged to attend Sunset Parade** and may **take photographs** during any awards or presentations their cadet receives.

OBSERVERS AND GUESTS – MARKS OF RESPECT

Visitors and parents observing the evening's parades are respectfully reminded of naval traditions and expected marks of respect during the ceremonies. Observers may be requested to stand at various times, including:

- During the **playing of "O Canada"** (National Anthem).
- On the **arrival or departure of the Reviewing Party** and/or the **Commanding Officer**.
- During the **playing of "Sunset" or "God Save the King."**
- At **any other time** the **Executive Officer** or **Master of Ceremonies** requests spectators to rise.

Your cooperation in observing these customs helps set the proper tone of respect and discipline that our cadets are learning to uphold.
