Subject: Opposition to Wildflower Music Park – Zoning Inconsistencies and Rural Protection

Dear Commissioners,

I am writing to oppose any zoning change, special exception, or Temporary Use Permit that would enable the proposed Wildflower Music Park to operate as a commercial festival or event venue. The site is currently zoned for rural/agricultural use, and that classification was established to preserve farmland, protect existing residents, and prevent incompatible high-impact uses.
