ZONING

Our community is zoned agricultural and residential, not for large commercial venues. Allowing a high-impact event use here would set a precedent that could change Melrose forever.

TRAFFIC

NE 255th Drive and the connecting roads are narrow, unpaved, and rural. They were never designed for thousands of cars, delivery trucks, or RVs. Increased traffic would create dust, noise, and dangerous congestion on roads that already require cautious driving and regular maintenance.

WATER

The land sits above sensitive aquifer recharge areas and near local lakes. With no proper sewer or wastewater plan, runoff and pollution threaten the clean water that sustains our community.

WILDLIFE

Protected species — including gopher tortoises, indigo snakes, eagles, and sandhill cranes — depend on these habitats. Noise, clearing, and lights disrupt the fragile balance of Melrose's natural environment.

COMMUNITY

Melrose is built on neighbors, farms, and peace. Growth is welcome when it fits our land use and preserves our quality of life.
