

Protect Our Farmland – Say No to Wildflowers Music Park Exemptions

Parcel of Concern: 18880-002-000 (adjacent property)

■ Land Use Conflict

Property is zoned Agricultural.

Agricultural zoning is meant for farming, wildlife, and rural living — not large commercial music festivals.

Granting an exemption here weakens farmland protections for the entire county.

■ Traffic & Safety

Access is via a narrow, unpaved road — in many places, only one vehicle can pass.

Large events will overwhelm traffic, block emergency vehicles, and endanger residents.

■ Noise & Quality of Life

Multi-day amplified music and late-night activity will:

- Disturb families, elderly, and disabled neighbors.
- Reduce property values.
- Permanently change the quiet rural character of this area.

■ Environment & Wildlife

Property includes wetlands and habitats for:

- Gopher tortoises
- Deer
- Bald eagles

Clearing land and hosting thousands of visitors threatens these sensitive resources.

■ Our Request

Deny any zoning exemptions or special permits for Wildflowers Music Park.

Require independent studies on traffic, noise, and environmental impacts.

Uphold the Comprehensive Plan and protect rural land from incompatible development.

Farmland is for food, not festivals.

Rules for all — no special exemptions.
