How to Begin

Practical Steps for Exploration

- **Research Your Professors:** If you're unfamiliar with a Professor, look them up online. Their lessons, gifts, and wisdom await discovery.
- Ask for Guidance: Before researching, say, "Guide me to the messages you want me to find."
- **Engage in Meditation:** Invite your Professor into your meditation and jot down any insights.
- **Seek Evidence:** Ask for signs of their presence. Trust what comes, even if it seems subtle or surprising.
- **Dive Deeper:** Study their quotes, writings, or favorite things. Explore their life, and see what resonates with your own.
- Focus on Images: Examine the images on their card and look up their spiritual meanings.

Special Tips

- Repetition Matters: Drawing the same Professor repeatedly means they have more to teach.
- The ??? Card: This unique card invites you to connect with a Professor not in the deck. Close your eyes and ask, "Who wants to work with me today?" Trust the first name that comes to mind.
- Daily Practice: Choose one Professor per day and allow them to work with you.
