ORDINANCE NO. 105 OF THE ORDINANCES
OF THE TOWN OF EAU PLEINE ENTITLED
"GENERAL RELIEF--LEGAL SETTLEMENT AND WORK RELIEF"

The Town Board of the Town of Eau Pleine do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 105 of the ordinances of the Town of Eau Pleine entitled "General Relief--Legal Settlement and Work Relief" is hereby created as follows:

104 GENERAL RELIEF--LEGAL SETTLEMENT AND WORK RELIEF

(1) Purposes.

It is declared legislative policy of the State of Wisconsin as appears in Sec. 49.002 of the Wisconsin Statutes that refusal of a bona fide offer of employment or training without good cause, or acceptance and subsequent inadequate performance through willful neglect, shall necessitate that local municipal or county welfare officials discontinue general relief payments to such individuals. It is contemplated that certain dependent persons as defined in Sec. 49.01(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes where legal settlements are within the Town of Eau Pleine, Marathon County, leave this Town and apply for general assistance in other municipalities within the State of Wisconsin and certain of these individuals will leave this Town for the express purpose of avoiding the newly implemented work relief program. Since other counties and municipalities also maintain such programs they should place such individuals on their programs in their respective municipalities because of the inability of the municipality of legal settlement to force such persons to return to their municipalities of legal settlement.

(2) Town Relief Program.

The Town of Eau Pleine shall maintain a continuing work relief program for all eligible welfare recipients and pursuant thereto hereby notifies all Wisconsin counties and through each county clerk each municipality of the same.

(3) Notification to Relief Recipient.

The Town of Eau Pleine by this ordinance requests each county and/or municipality to notify each welfare recipient whose legal settlement is presumed to be within the Town of Eau Pleine of the work relief program within the Town of Eau Pleine.

(4) Placement of Relief Recipients in Work Relief Programs.

The Town of Eau Pleine upon receiving a non-resident notice pursuant to Sec. 49.11(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes for

relief recipients whose legal settlement is presumed to be in the Town of Eau Pleine shall contact the forwarding county or municipality (if within Marathon County) with the request that if such county or municipality has a work relief program, the recipient in question shall be certified for placement therein.

(5) Refusal to Work.

The Town of Eau Pleine shall deny any claims submitted by a county or municipality for general relief for any recipient who refuses to accept a bona fide offer of employment from said county or municipality without good cause. Documentation as to the recipient's refusal shall be submitted to the Town of Eau Pleine.

(6) Notification.

Upon passage and publication the Town of Eau Pleine Town Clerk is directed to contact each county within the State of Wisconsin and notify each of said counties of the passage of this ordinance.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
