THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF EAU PLEINE, Marathon County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 109 of the Town of Eau Pleine entitled "A JOINT ACTION EMERGENCY GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF MARATHON AND THE TOWN OF EAU PLEINE PROVIDING FOR A CIVIL DEFENSE ORGANIZATION AND FOR PROTECTION AND PROMOTION OF PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE IN THE COUNTY OF MARATHON DURING CIVIL DEFENSE EMERGENCIES RESULTING FROM ENEMY ACTION AND WITH EMERGENCIES RESULTING FROM NATURAL OR MAN-MADE DISASTERS" is hereby created to read and provide as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 109. A JOINT ACTION EMERGENCY  
GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF MARATHON AND  
THE TOWN OF EAU PLEINE PROVIDING FOR A CIVIL DEFENSE  
ORGANIZATION AND FOR PROTECTION AND PROMOTION OF PUBLIC  
SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE IN THE COUNTY OF MARATHON  
DURING CIVIL DEFENSE EMERGENCIES RESULTING FROM ENEMY  
ACTION AND WITH EMERGENCIES RESULTING FROM NATURAL OR  
MAN-MADE DISASTERS.

(1) COUNTY ORDINANCE ADOPTED. Joint Action Emergency Government Ordinance Number 67 of the Board of Supervisors of Marathon County providing for a county-municipal joint action civil defense plan of organization as adopted by the County Board on the 24th day of May, 1977, is made a part hereof by reference and is hereby ratified and accepted by the Town of Eau Pleine as provided by Section III of said Joint Action Ordinance.

(2) EMERGENCY GOVERNMENT DIRECTOR. The County/Municipal Emergency Government Director, appointed and employed by the Marathon County Board as provided in County Ordinance Number 67 is hereby designated and appointed Emergency Government Director for the Town of Eau Pleine subject to the conditions and provisions of the Wisconsin Statutes and the said Marathon County Joint Action Ordinance.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.

A JOINT ACTION CIVIL DEFENSE ORDINANCE BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF MARATHON AND MUNICIPALITIES OF Town of Eau Pleine TO COPE WITH CIVIL DEFENSE EMERGENCIES RESULTING FROM ENEMY ACTION AND WITH EMERGENCIES RESULTING FROM NATURAL DISASTERS.

The municipality of Town of Eau Pleine does ordain as follows:

SECTION I. A Joint Action Ordinance of the Board of Supervisors of Marathon County providing for a county-municipal joint action civil defense plan of organization adopted by said County Board on the 6th day of June, 1967. A copy of said County Ordinance is attached hereto, and made a part hereof, by reference, and is hereby ratified and accepted by the municipality of Town of Eau Pleine, County of Marathon.

This ratification and acceptance of the Joint Action Ordinance shall constitute a Mutual Agreement between the municipality of Town of Eau Pleine and the County of Marathon as provided by Section 3 of said Joint Action Ordinance.

SECTION II. The County Municipal Civil Defense Director, appointed and employed by the Marathon County Board as provided in the referred to Ordinance is hereby designated and appointed Civil Defense Director for the municipality of Town of Eau Pleine, subject to the conditions and provisions as set forth in the Wisconsin Statutes, and the Marathon County Joint Action Ordinance.

SECTION III. All ordinances and/or resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from, and after, its passage and publication.

SECTION V. This Ordinance was passed on the 21st of December, 1972.
