AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A CODE REGULATING TRAFFIC AT THE INTERSECTION OF EAU PLEINE ROAD AND LINCOLN AVENUE MAINTAINED BY THE TOWNS OF BRIGHTON AND EAU PLEINE, MARATHON COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Eau Pleine, Marathon County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. STATE TRAFFIC LAWS ADOPTED. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this code, the statutory provisions in chapter 340 to 348, of the Wisconsin Statutes, describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic, exclusive of any provisions therein relating to penalties to be imposed and exclusive of any regulation for which the statutory penalty is fine or term of imprisonment are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this code as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this code. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this code in order to secure uniform statewide regulation of traffic on the highways, streets and alleys of the State of Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. CONTROLLED INTERSECTIONS DESIGNATED. In the interest in public safety, the following intersection is declared a controlled intersection and traffic control signals shall be installed thereon in conformity with the Wisconsin Official Traffic Control Device Manual and the provisions of this code:

The intersection of Eau Pleine Road with Lincoln Avenue.

SECTION 3. DESIGNATION OF LOCATION OF STOP SIGNS. In the interests of public safety stop signs shall be installed at the following locations to control traffic on the highways over which the Towns of Brighton and Eau Pleine, Marathon County have exclusive jurisdiction:

On Eau Pleine Road at its intersection with Lincoln Avenue.

At the northeast corner of the intersection of Eau Pleine Road with Lincoln Avenue for traffic on Eau Pleine Road to stop before or crossing entering Lincoln Avenue.

SECTION 4. OPERATORS TO OBEY TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES. Every operator of a vehicle approaching an intersection at which an Official Traffic Control Device is erected in accordance with this section shall obey the direction of such Official Traffic Control device as required by the Wisconsin Statutes incorporated by reference in Section One of this code. Operators of vehicles approaching a stop sign shall stop before entering a highway as

required by 346.46, Wis. Stats. Operators approaching intersections at which a yield sign has been installed shall yield the right-of-way to other vehicles as required by 346.18(6), Wis. Stats.

ORDINANCE 96-1

STOP SIGN ORDINANCE FOR THE INTERSECTION OF EAU PLEINE ROAD AND
LINCOLN AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Eau Pleine, Marathon County did, on August 27, 1996 adopt Ordinance No. 96-1 entitled Stop Sign Ordinance for the Intersection of Eau Pleine Road & Lincoln Avenue.

WHEREAS, due to changes in traffic volume, it becomes necessary to control this intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Eau Pleine, County of Marathon does Create and adopt the attached ordinance 96-1 entitled "Stop Sign Ordinance for the Intersection of Eau Pleine Road and Lincoln Avenue".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as required by law.

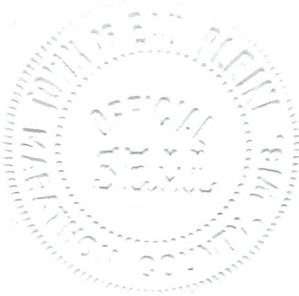
