MONTHLY BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Monday, August 10th, 2026

- I. CALL TO ORDER:** The Town of Eau Pleine monthly town board meeting was called to order by Chairman Mark Radke at 7:30pm on August 10th, 2026, at the Town of Eau Pleine Town Hall, 111630 Equity St, Stratford, WI 54484. The clerk verified Proper posting of Meeting Notice and Agenda.

- III. PUBLIC COMMENT/INPUT:** Various conversations about town signs and roads were had by board and residents.
- IV. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:** The board had previously received copies of the minutes from the last board meeting on July 13th, 2026. Motion/Second by BR/KS to dispense with reading and approve the minutes as written. Motion carried.
- V. TREASURER'S REPORT:** Shirley read the Treasurer's report. Balance on hand as of 7/31/26 General Account \$83,014.81, Tax Account \$5.73, Money Market Account \$97,362.09, Total Cash on Hand \$180,382.63. Motion/Second by KS/BR to accept the treasurer's report as read. Motion carried.
- VI. CLERK'S REPORT:**
- The Partisan Primary election is tomorrow, August 11th 2026. Voting machines were publicly tested on Wednesday August 5th 2026 and are ready to use.
 - The Open book and Board of Review dates will be posted in the Record Review before August 24th, 2026. Motion/Second by BR/KS to approve the clerk's report. Motion carried.

- Mark Landwehr, our road patrolman, has been grating the roads according to traffic and roughness.
 - The Abe Lincoln Bridge project was slightly delayed because the concrete gurters were the incorrect size. They still estimate the project will be finished by the second week of September.
 - Mark Landwehr talked to American Asphalt about creating an apron off of County Road E while the asphalt is cheaper. Motion/Second by KS/BR to add 30 feet of asphalt apron to the East and West of Equity Street off County Road E at the approximate price of \$1600.00. Motion carried.
