**MONTHLY BOARD MEETING MINUTES**  
**Tuesday, May 12th, 2026**

- I. **CALL TO ORDER:** The Town of Eau Pleine monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Mark Radke at 7:30pm on May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at the Town of Eau Pleine Town Hall, 111630 Equity St, Stratford, WI 54484. The clerk verified proper posting of Meeting Notice and Agenda.

  - Motion/Second by KS/BR to accept the bid of \$9.95/yard from Paul Bugar Trucking for Decomposed Granite. Motion carried.
  - Motion/Second by KS/BR to accept the bid of \$10.18/yard from Paul Bugar Trucking for Crushed/Screen Rock less than ¾". Motion Carried.
  - Motion/Second by KS/BR to accept the bid of \$10.48/yard from Paul Bugar Trucking for Mix Fine Crushed Granite. Motion Carried.
  - Motion/Second by KS/BR to accept the bid of \$1.59/gal from Kafka Dust Busters for 38% Calcium Chloride and \$0.15/gal for Beet Juice dust inhibitor. Motion carried.
- IV. **PUBLIC COMMENT:** Various conversations by residents about dust control, especially for safety purposes.
- V. **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:** The town board had previously received copies of the minutes from the April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2026 meeting. Motion/Second by KS/BR to dispense with reading the minutes and accept them as written. Motion carried.
- VI. **TREASURER’S REPORT:** Shirley read the Treasurer’s report. Balance on hand as of 4/30/2026 General Account \$133,148.14, Tax Account \$12,361.31, Money Market Account \$97,227.24. Total Cash on Hand \$242,736.69. Motion/Second by BR/KS to accept the treasurer’s report as read. Motion carried.
- VII. **CLERK’S REPORT:** None.
- VIII. **ROADS & SIGNS:** Brush cutting will happen in late June throughout the whole township.
- IX. **SANITATION/RECYCLING:** None.
- X. **ZONING:** The board discussed the petition for rezone change from Jeffrey and Ann Joswiak on property located in the township. Motion/Second by KS/BR to accept the Joswiak rezone from Low Density Residential to General Agriculture. Motion Carried.
- XI. **FIRE COMMISSIONER REPORT:** None.
- XII. **CORRESPONDENCE/OTHER:**
  - MR and KS attended the intergovernmental meeting where discussion was had that it would be in the town’s best interest to speak with their board members about engaging in a financial agreement with the neighboring towns of Brighton and Green Valley to share legal fees relating to the wind ordinance.

Due to the scale of many newer wind turbines, our previous ordinance covers some but not all wind equipment. The new ordinance would need to be drafted to cover up to 100Mw.

- Motion/Second by KS/BR to contact our previous attorney and start drafting a wind ordinance for greater than 100Mw. Motion carried.
- Motion/Second by BR/KS to approve a letter of engagement between the towns of Brighton and Green Valley for the purpose of cost sharing legal fees for a new wind ordinance. Motion carried.
- Maple Ridge Dairy is seeking permission to bore under March Rapids Ave for the purpose of a water line. Motion/Second by KS/BR to approve Maple Ridge Dairy's request to bore under March Rapids Ave at their own expense. Motion Carried.
- Little Rose Solar has started work on their project, though the Town of Eau Pleine has received to application for a permit. MR will contact the attorney about how we should move forward.

**XIII. PAYMENT OF BILLS:** Motion/Second by KS/BR to approve payment of the bills. Motion carried.

**XIV. NEXT MEETING:** The next meeting is scheduled for June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at 7:30pm.

**XV. ADJOURNMENT:** Motion/Second by BR/KS to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 8:50pm.
