**MONTHLY BOARD MEETING MINUTES**

**Tuesday, January 13th, 2026**

- I. CALL TO ORDER:** The Town of Eau Pleine monthly town board meeting was called to order by Chairman Mark Radke at 7:30pm on January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at the Town of Eau Pleine Town Hall, 111630 Equity St, Stratford, WI 54484. The clerk verified Proper posting of Meeting Notice and Agenda.

  - Conversation about Act 71 which would allow the board to appoint Treasurers and Clerks instead of electing them has passed in Wisconsin. The board will research and discuss more at the February monthly meeting.
