MONTHLY BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, June 9th, 2026

- I. CALL TO ORDER:** The Town of Eau Pleine monthly town board meeting was called to order by Chairman Mark Radke at 7:30pm on June 9th, 2026, at the Town of Eau Pleine Town Hall, 111630 Equity St, Stratford, WI 54484. The clerk verified Proper posting of Meeting Notice and Agenda.
- II. ATTENDANCE:** Mark Radke (hereinafter MR), Kurt Schwarze (hereinafter KS), Brian Radke (hereinafter BR), Heather Kops, Shirley Hein, Alan Leffel, Cheryl Schulte
- III. PUBLIC COMMENT/INPUT:** Residents and board members discuss various roads and signs topics.
- IV. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:** The board had previously received copies of the minutes from the last board meeting on May 12th, 2026. Motion/Second by KS/BR to dispense with reading and approve the minutes as written. Motion carried.
- V. TREASURER'S REPORT:** Shirley read the Treasurer's report. Balance on hand as of 5/31/26 General Account \$136,842.02, Tax Account \$5.73, Money Market Account \$97,269.73, Total Cash on Hand \$234,117.48. Motion/Second by BR/KS to accept the treasurer's report as read. Motion carried.
- VI. CLERK'S REPORT:** Board discusses the Act 71 law making it possible for a township to move from an elected to an appointed clerk and treasurer position. Motion/Second by BR/KS to schedule a special elector meeting on Monday July 13th, 2026 to discuss and vote on creating a hired, salaried or waged clerk and treasurer position, with the regular monthly meeting to follow. Motion carried.
- VII. ROADS & SIGNS:**
- Motion/Second by KS/BR to bill Marathon County \$1750.00 for Calcium Chloride on Big Rapids Road. Motion carried.
 - MR discusses locations where granite will be spread in the township. Mark Landwehr will start ditch-cutting next week, weather permitting.
- VIII. SANITATION/RECYCLING: None.**
- IX. ZONING: None.**
- X. FIRE COMMISSIONER'S REPORT:** KS informs the board that the fire department plans to asphalt the parking lot next year. They are currently taking bids.
- XI. CORRESPONDENCE/OTHER:**
- Shirley sent an action letter to a property owner in the township asking for them to remove debris from the right-of-way as it is a safety hazard, and if not taken care of by June 8th, the township will complete the removal and invoice the resident for the work.
 - Kurt attended an Intergovernmental Meeting last night where the major takeaway was to ask residents to be more involved and speak up about the future of wind projects in the area. Opportunities for residents to get involved are posted on our township website as well as various locations around the township including the town hall and recycling center.
