MONTHLY BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Monday, July 13th, 2026

- I. CALL TO ORDER:** The Town of Eau Pleine monthly town board meeting was called to order by Chairman Mark Radke at 7:30pm on July 13th, 2026, at the Town of Eau Pleine Town Hall, 111630 Equity St, Stratford, WI 54484. The clerk verified Proper posting of Meeting Notice and Agenda.
- II. ATTENDANCE:** Mark Radke (hereinafter MR), Kurt Schwarze (hereinafter KS), Brian Radke (hereinafter BR), Heather Kops, Shirley Hein, Al Leffel, Rick Sischo, Mark Landwehr, Julie and Jeff Stueber, Randy Lau, Cindy Nelson, and Alliant Energy Representative-Matthew Boon.
- III. PUBLIC COMMENT/INPUT:** JJ's brush cutting completed their cleanup. Mark Landwehr also spent time cleaning brush in areas.
- IV. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:** The board had previously received copies of the minutes from the last board meeting on June 9th, 2026. Motion/Second by KS/BR to dispense with reading and approve the minutes as written. Motion carried.
- V. TREASURER'S REPORT:** Shirley read the Treasurer's report. Balance on hand as of 6/30/26 General Account \$76,090.25, Tax Account \$5.73, Money Market Account \$97,316.63, Total Cash on Hand \$173,412.61. Motion/Second by BR/KS to accept the treasurer's report as read. Motion carried.
- VI. CLERK'S REPORT:** The next election is the Partisan Primary on August 11th 2026.
- VII. ROADS & SIGNS:**
- The town sign is hanging upside down and is fading. Mark Landwehr is going to look into a fix.
 - Mark Landwehr finished the brush pile cleanup for a resident. Motion/Second by KS/BR to invoice the resident \$100.00 for cleaning up the pile of brush in the right of way. Motion Carried.
 - The county has asked us to create a contract with them going forward if we wish to continue to be reimbursed for Calcium Chloride on Big Rapids Road. MR will be reaching out to the county to proceed for next year.
 - Jeff Stueber requested information on how to proceed with excessive silt in the ditch by his property. Mark Landwehr will visit the area to get a better idea of how to proceed.
- VIII. SANITATION/RECYCLING:** None.
- IX. ZONING:** The Town of Eau Pleine board will be holding a special meeting on July 21st at 6:00pm to discuss Marathon County's proposed large electric energy facility moratorium.
- X. FIRE COMMISSIONER'S REPORT:**
- The fire department is currently taking bid to redo the parking lot in full.
 - KS informed the board that Farm Tech Days is paying the fire department to have emergency staff at the event.
