**MONTHLY BOARD MEETING MINUTES**  
**Tuesday, February 10th, 2026**

- I. CALL TO ORDER:** The Town of Eau Pleine monthly town board meeting was called to order by Chairman Mark Radke at 7:30pm on February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at the Town of Eau Pleine Town Hall, 111630 Equity St, Stratford, WI 54484. The clerk verified proper posting of Meeting Notice and Agenda.
- II. ATTENDANCE:** Mark Radke (hereinafter referred to as MR), Kurt Schwarze (hereinafter referred to as KS), Brian Radke (hereinafter referred to as BR), Shirley Hein, Heather Kops, Alan Leffel, Warren Manecke, Mark Wesle
- III. PUBLIC COMMENT/INPUT:** Various discussion about local solar projects; No new information currently to share.
- IV. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:** The town board had previously received copies of the minutes from the January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025 meeting. Motion/Second by KS/BR to dispense with reading the minutes and accept them as written. Motion carried.
- V. TREASURER'S REPORT:** Shirley read the Treasurer's report. Balance on hand as of 1/31/2026 General Account \$76,701.08, Tax Account \$158,941.73, Money Market Account \$97,093.47. Total Cash on Hand \$332,736.28. Motion/Second by KS/BR to accept the treasurer's report as read. Motion carried.
- VI. CLERK'S REPORT:** None.
- VII. ROADS & SIGNS:**
- An estimate was received from the DOT for the Abe Lincoln Road; Carlson Creek Bridge project. MR will be following up with Rozy Coppenger from the DOT to confirm the final cost for the township.
  - The board reviewed the WTA Transportation Resolution and how it could help the town financially with future road and culvert projects. Motion/Second made by KS/BR to Adopt the WTA Transportation Resolution. Motion carried.
- VIII. SANITATION/RECYCLING:** None.
- IX. ZONING:**
- The board discussed the Farm Consolidation Amendment from Marathon County Zoning. The form gives the board a chance to share their recommendations for potential updates to the Farm Preservation Ordinance. Motion/Second by BR/KS to support Option #2 which would clarify language in the current process, making it easier for property owners to comply with state regulations. Motion carried.
  - The Marathon County 2026 Comprehensive Zoning was read and analyzed. Motion/Second by KS/BR to Adopt 2026 Marathon County Zoning, again. Motion carried.
  - A Resolution on Zoning Ordinance Amendment was received from Marathon County Zoning for the rezone of Kenneth and Mary Leick Trust Property. Motion/Second by BR/KS to approve the rezoning. Motion carried.
- X. FIRE COMMISSIONER REPORT:** KS informed the board that the fire department has installed cameras.
- XI. CORRESPONDENCE/OTHER:**
- During the budget meeting for 2026, the board agreed to install internet at the town hall. Motion/Second by BR/KS to go ahead with Spectrum as the provider was made. Motion carried.
  - MR informed the board that the April 1<sup>st</sup> 2025 lawsuit with a resident who had an unfortunate fall outside of the town hall during the election has been closed.
- XII. PAYMENT OF BILLS:** Motion/Second by KS/BR to approve payment of the bills. Motion carried.
