cancer treatment to attend Kamp.

Excitement, fun, and adventure are planned for campers. They have the opportunity to take part in recreational activities such as swimming, canoeing, crafts, games, pottery, candle making, drawing, beading, camping and more. A fishing excursion is also planned, with a fish fry to follow the next night for everyone. Music, skits, parties and traditional evening campfires add to the fun.
