NOTE: The Fresh Start Act of 2019 provides that no person shall be disqualified from pursuing, practicing or engaging in any occupation for which a license is required solely or in part because of a prior conviction of a crime, unless the crime for which the person was convicted directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the occupation of cosmetology, esthetics, or manicurist. A person with a criminal record may petition the Board at any time for a determination of whether the person's criminal record will disqualify that person from obtaining a license. (SB 2781 effective July 1, 2019)
