WOOLVERSTONE HALL

Built in 1776, Woolverstone Hall is a Grade I listed building set in 80 acres of parkland on the banks of the River Orwell. It is widely thought of as one of the finest examples of Palladian architecture in England.

In 1930s, the Woolverstone estate was sold to Lord Nuffield, then during the Second World War it was requisitioned as a naval training establishment. Becoming HMS Woolverstone, a shore-based naval station. Dummy landing crafts were made there as part of the deceptions that went on around D-Day.

After the war, in 1950, the London County Council took it over as a boys' boarding School thus beginning Woolverstone's heritage as a school. In 1992 it was sold to Ipswich High School who moved to Woolverstone from central Ipswich.

To this day, Woolverstone Hall continues to be a fantastic day and boarding school, stunning venue for theatre, sports, weddings, and one of the finest country house Classic Vehicle Show venues Suffolk has to offer.
