



A LEGACY OF FAMILY, FUN & CHAMPIONSHIPS

We're thrilled guest speaker, Hank Pfister, Jr., is joining us for this landmark birthday. Hank's roots at BRC run deep.




Every year, we have the privilege of honoring a member who embodies the giving spirit of The Racquet Club with the Steve Holloway Volunteer of the Year Award.
