9:23: Credentials report. Voting strength numbers have not changed. 2216 is the official voting strength.

9:38: Jeremy Miller addresses the convention, Tyler Kistner addresses the convention, Ciciely Davis addresses the convention, Kurt Daudt addresses the convention, Tom Emmer addresses the convention.

10:30: Motion and second to stop having speakers and to move to the gubernatorial endorsement. Motion passes.

10:33: Patti Meier gives nominations committee report. All candidates are qualified. Speaking order is: Shah, Jensen, Qualls, Murphy, and Gazelka.

12:00: Final credentials report given. Motion and second to accept. Passes. 12:01: Motion and second to consider a governor endorsement. Motion Passes. 12:02: First round of voting begins.

12:18: First round of voting: Jensen 555 (26.52%), Kendall Qualls 484 (23.12%), Murphy 392 (18.73%), Shah 333 (15.91%), Gazelka 316 (15.10%), Undecided 7 (.33%), No Endorsement 5 (.24%), No preference 1 (.05%).
