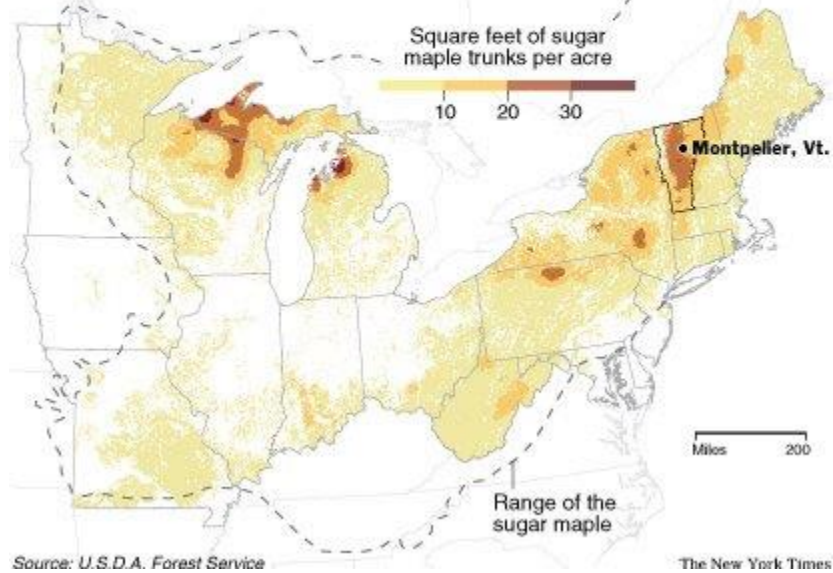


Where Do Maple Trees Grow?

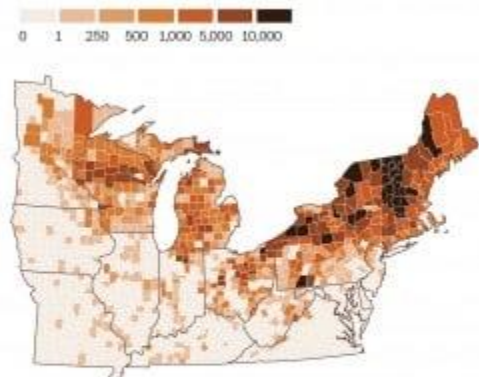
Sugar Maple Tree Distribution

Sugar maple tree sap, which can be processed into syrup, is generally collected when below-freezing nighttime temperatures and mild daytime temperatures cause the sap to flow.

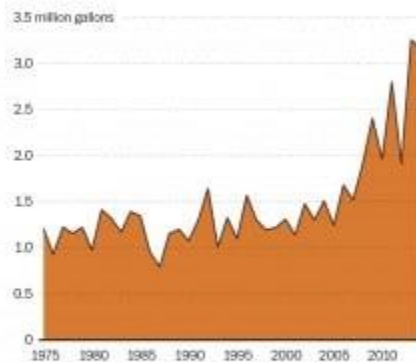


Where the sap flows
