Sportsmanship Statement

USA Diving promotes good sportsmanship by athletes, coaches and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Profanity, racist or sexist comments, or other intimidating actions directed at judges, meet personnel, athletes, coaches, spectators, or team representatives are grounds for removal from the site of competition. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Anti-bullying Policy

Hazing, harassment, intimidation, menacing or bullying, and acts of cyberbullying by members towards any member is strictly prohibited. Retaliation against any person who reports, is thought to have reported, files a complaint or otherwise participates in an investigation or inquiry is also strictly prohibited. False charges shall also be regarded as a serious offense and will result in disciplinary action or other appropriate sanctions. Persons whose behavior is found to be in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline, up to and including expulsion. USA Diving may also make referrals to law enforcement officials.

Use of Audiovisual Equipment

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.

Deck Changing

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or designated changing rooms is not appropriate and is prohibited.

MEET INFORMATION

Entering the Meet

All athlete and coach entries must be made online at www.divemeets.com prior to **June 13th, 2022**.

Entry Fees

Entry fees are \$50 plus a \$30 insurance fee per athlete per event (total \$80 per event).

Late Registration

Coaches – If a coach misses the online registration deadline, a \$20 late fee will be assessed prior to deck authorization.

Athletes – If registering for the meet after the entry deadline, a \$100 late fee will be assessed in addition to the event entry fees.

Each event closes 3 hours prior to the event start time.

Dive Changes

Dive changes will be allowed until 3 hours prior to the start of each event. A \$15 late fee will be assessed for any dive changes made after 6pm the night before the first day's events, and after 12pm the day before the remaining days.

First day of competition: Dive changes must be made prior to 6pm the day before to avoid late fee

All remaining days of competition: Dive changes must be made prior to 12pm the day before to avoid late fee

Spectator tickets on sale at door – \$10/day. Children under 5 are free.

Parents must stay off deck. Spectator viewing area is upstairs, right of aquatic center lobby. Please bring water bottles; it will be hot in viewing area.

Pool Equipment

2 maxi-flex "B" 1-meters and 2 maxi-flex "B" 3-meters on cement, plus 1, 3, 5, 7, 10-meters.

Trampoline and dryboard will be closed. Please do not allow athletes on the equipment. Mats will be available.

There is a Tivo on the 1-meter side and 3-meter side.

Directions to Pool

Approaching from I-17 North (Phoenix): Take exit 341 for McConnell Dr. Follow McConnell Dr. to San Francisco St. and take a left. The parking garage and ATC will be on your left.

Approaching from I-40 West (Albuquerque): Take exit 195 and merge onto I-17 North. In less than a mile, take exit 341 for McConnell Dr. Follow McConnell Dr. to San Francisco St. and take a left. The parking garage and ATC will be on your left.

Approaching from I-40 East (Los Angeles and Kingman): Take exit 195 toward AZ 89A/Phoenix/Flagstaff, and then merge onto I-17 North. From there, take exit 341 for McConnell Dr. Follow McConnell Dr. to San Francisco St. and take a left. The parking garage and ATC will be on your left.

Parking Information

Team/Fan Parking: The entrance to the ATC is located on the east side of the building on San Francisco Street. Teams/fans can park in the San Francisco Street parking garage south of the ATC for a daily fee. There is some metered parking on Franklin St., just north of aquatic center.
