BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF THURSTON, NEW YORK, ADOPTED JULY 16, 2025, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$410,000 TO FINANCE THE ACQUISITION OF A ROAD GRADER, STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS \$410,000 AND APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT FOR SUCH PURPOSE

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the acquisition of a road grader, at the estimated maximum cost of \$410,000. The Town has applied for financing through the USDA Rural Development, Community Facilities Loan Program and the financing may be provided through said program or from other financing sources.

The period of usefulness is fifteen (15) years.

The maximum amount of obligations authorized to be issued is \$410,000. Any grant funds received by the Town in connection with the acquisition of the road grader shall be used to pay all or a part of the cost thereof, and the principal amount of bonds or notes issued pursuant to this resolution shall be reduced by a like amount.
